
Experience



Our Plan and Vision

Japan has been plagued with disaster after disaster. They have suffered earthquakes, tsunamis, nuclear radiation, a devastated economy, and thousands of suicides each year! Since 2008, there has been 30,000 suicides every year! One Japanese man named, Naoki Tachiwana, told how he didn't see a need to live and was looking for someone to commit suicide with him. Taro, another Japanese man, said that he was so ashamed that he couldn't support his wife and kids that he attempted to commit suicide but didn't succeed. You will find story after story of suicide in Japan. Many blame it on the economy, but I know it is simply a lack of relationship with Jesus Christ. There have been many disasters in Japan! The biggest disaster, however, has been the lack of churches preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Our vision is to start indigenous churches all through Japan by leading people to the Lord, baptizing, and training leaders; leaders that will be able to effectively reach their own people. We plan to finish deputation by the end of 2015 and spend two years in Japan learning language and culture. After language school we will begin our first church plant. **We long to take the message of the risen Son to the land of the rising sun!**

To Those Considering Missionary Will Hill,

Brother Will Hill came to Lighthouse Baptist Church for the purpose of entering our missionary training program. He had already spent six months in Peru, SA for missionary training. He spent three years in intensive Bible College classes and one on one mentoring by myself and key members of my staff. The missionary training program required Bro. Hill to preach and/or teach a minimum of one hundred times and to win and disciple several new converts. While in the training program, Will developed a New Move-In Ministry by selecting and training several key couples within our church to reach out to families that had recently moved into our community. He became the editor for our *InVision Magazine*, and he taught the Senior High Teen Sunday School Class. In addition to these accomplishments he also performed baptisms, served the Lord's Supper, worked in a campus ministry at North Ga. College, held leadership positions in several youth camps and Bible schools and mentored several students some of whom are now in various Bible Colleges or missionary training programs. He and his wife have an excellent testimony and maintain high standards.

A graduation requirement was for each missionary to start a new Sunday School class and develop a leader to take the class upon his leaving. Brother Will started a class for college age singles. This class has been a blessing to our church and continues strong under the leadership of Will's brother Chris Hill. After graduation, he decided to remain in an intern program and continued to work in our Sunday School. He also developed and operated a Saturday night program to spend time with and reach neighborhood teens.

After three years in our missions training program and three years as an intern I believe that Bro. Hill has the experience necessary to do well on the mission field. I know for a certain that he loves the Lord and has a deep burden for the Japanese people. No one will work harder to reach the Japanese for Christ. His wife, Rebelle, comes from a great church that is very fundamental and missions-minded. She has a brother in China and one in South America. Rebelle is excited to follow her husband to the mission field and she is just the kind of help-meet that he needs as a missionary.



Doctrinal statement

The Bible - We believe that the BIBLE is the WORD OF GOD, and that it is divinely inspired. We believe in the plenary, verbal inspiration, that it is the only complete and final revelation of the will of GOD to man, and the supreme, infallible authority in all matters of faith and conduct. God - We believe in the Trinity, the unity of the Godhead. There are three persons: The FATHER, The SON, and The HOLY SPIRIT. They are equally perfect in every divine quality, and execute distinct but harmonious offices in the great work of redemption. (A) We believe in GOD the FATHER (B) We believe in JESUS CHRIST (C) We believe in the HOLY SPIRIT. Genesis 1:1,26; John 1:1,3; Matthew 28:19; John 4:24; Romans 1:19,20; Ephesians 4:5,6; I John 5:7

The Father - We believe in God the Father, an infinite, personal spirit, perfect in holiness, wisdom, power and love. We believe that He infallibly foreknows all that shall come to pass, that He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of men, that He hears and answers prayer, and that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ. Luke 10:21,22; Matthew 23:9; John 3:16; 6:27; Romans 1:7; I Timothy 1:1,2; 2:5,6; I Peter 1:3; Revelation 1:6

Jesus Christ - We believe in Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son, conceived by the Holy Spirit. We believe Jesus Christ is God. We believe in His virgin birth, sinless life, miracles, and teachings. We believe in His substitutionary atoning death, bodily resurrection, ascension into heaven, perpetual intercession for His people, and personal visible return to earth. Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 1:26-38; John 1:1; 20:28; Romans 9:5; 8:46; II Corinthians 5:21; I Peter 2:21-23; John 20:30, 31; Matthew 20:28; Ephesians 1:4; Acts 1:11; Romans 5:6-8; 6:9,10; Hebrews 7:25; Hebrews 9:28; I Timothy 3:16

The Holy Spirit - We believe in the person of the Holy Spirit who came forth from the Father and Son to convict the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment, and to regenerate, sanctify, and empower all who believe in Jesus Christ. We believe that the Holy Spirit indwells every believer in Christ, and that He is an abiding helper, teacher and guide. John 14:16,17,26; 15:26,27; John 16:9-14; Romans 8:9; I Corinthians 3:16; 6:19; Galatians 5:22-26

Man - We believe that all men by nature, choice and practice are sinners, but that "God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." We believe, therefore, that those who repent of their sins and by faith receive Christ as Lord and Savior will rejoice forever in God's presence, and those who refuse to receive Christ as Lord and Savior will be forever separated from God. Eternal State - We believe in a literal Heaven, the eternal home of the redeemed. We believe Heaven to be the literal place where the saved will live forever in the eternal bliss and blessings of God. We believe in Hell, the Christ-less eternity for the lost, where there will be burning and tormenting for those without salvation, who have refused to receive the gospel and Jesus Christ as Lord. We believe that Hell, unbelievers, Satan and all the fallen angels shall be cast into the lake of fire to be tormented day and night forever and forever. Matthew 13:41-43; Mark 9:43-48; Luke 16:19-24; John 14:2; 2 Corinthians 5:8; Revelation 21-22

Salvation - We believe salvation involves the redemption of the whole man, and is offered freely to all who accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour, who by His own blood obtained eternal redemption for the believer. In its broadest sense salvation includes regeneration, justification, sanctification, and glorification. There is no salvation apart from personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord. Doctrinal statement

Baptism - We believe in baptism by immersion after salvation with no merit for salvation in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost (Spirit). We reject infant baptism and any form of sprinkling for infants or adults. Baptism is an outward expression of our faith in Jesus Christ and simply a public testimony of what God has done by His grace. Romans 6:1-5; Acts 8:36-38; Acts 2:41; Matthew 3:16; Matthew 28:19-20.24; John 14:2; 2 Corinthians 5:8; Revelation 21-22

The Church - We believe in the local church, consisting of a company of professing, born-again believers in Jesus Christ, immersed in a credible confession of faith, and associated for worship, work and fellowship. We believe that to those local churches we are committed, for perpetual observance of the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper, and that God has laid upon these churches the task of proclaiming to a lost world the acceptance of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and the enthroning of Him as Lord and Master. Its scriptural officers are pastors and deacons. While both men and women are gifted for service in the church, the office of pastor is limited to men as qualified by Scripture. Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Acts 2:42; Romans 6:3-5; I Corinthians 11:23-26; Ephesians 2:19-22; Ephesians 5:19-21; I Timothy 2:9-14; 3:1-15; 4:14; Hebrews 10:23-25

The Relationship between Church and State - We believe that every human being is responsible to God alone in all matters of faith; that each church is independent and autonomous and must be free from any ecclesiastical or political authority; therefore, Church and State must be kept separate as having different functions with each fulfilling its duties free from the dictation or patronage of the other. Matthew 22:21; Mark 12:17; Luke 20:25; Acts 5:29; I Timothy 2:5; Romans 13:1-7; 14:7-9,12

Spiritual Gifts - We believe that spiritual gifts are given to the church for the express purpose of winning the lost and edifying other believers. The Holy Spirit is given to each believer upon acceptance of Christ, and His purpose is to exalt and bring people to Christ. Speaking in tongues was the least important of these gifts and was given as a sign for unbelieving Jews. That is we do not teach or practice speaking in tongues. John 7:37-39; 14:17; Acts 2:38; I Corinthians 1:22; 3:16-17; 6:19-20; 12-1

Eternal Security - We believe in the eternal security of all blood-bought individuals or believers and that such inheritance is incorruptible, and undefiled, and that each believer is kept by the power of God and nothing can separate us from Him, ourselves included. We believe that believers can lose the joy of fellowship with God, can grieve God and can quench the Spirit of God in him or her, but not lose his/her salvation. John 3:16; 5:24; 6:37-39; 10:27-30; Romans 8:35-39; Philipians 1:6; Titus 1:2; I Peter 1:5; I John 5:11-13; Jude 24

World Evangelism - We believe that the apostolic office ceased with the death of the Apostles. We believe that it is His church that He promised continual existence, to continue the work He started until He comes again. We believe that the ministry of reconciliation is committed to every believer, and all are saints/priests of God. The Lord Jesus Christ has commanded the preaching of the gospel to all nations. It is the duty and privilege of every follower of Christ and of every church of the Lord Jesus Christ to endeavor to make disciples of all nations. Matthew 16:18; 28:18-20; Mark 16:15; John 20:21; Acts 1:8; 2 Corinthians 5:18-21; I Peter 2:9; Revelation 1:6; 5:10

Second Coming - We believe in the literal return of Jesus Christ to the clouds to take all saved people from the earth before the beginning of the Tribulation period. We believe in his bodily visible return with his saints at the close of the Tribulation period to rule and reign for a thousand years on earth. We believe that unbelievers will face God and be judged at the Great White Throne Judgment according to their works, not for salvation, but for their proper and rightful places in the lake of fire. I Thessalonians 4:13-18, Revelation 4:1, Matthew 16:27; Mark 14:62; John 14:3; Acts 1:11; Phil. 3:20; Thessalonians 4:15; II Timothy 4:1; Titus 2:13; I Corinthians 4:5; I Corinthians 15; II Thessalonians 1:7-10; Revelation 20:4-6, 11-15

Biblical Separation - We believe that all the saved should live in such a manner as not to bring reproach upon their Savior and Lord; and that separation from all religious apostasy, all worldly and sinful pleasures, practices and associations is commanded of God. II Timothy 3:1-5; Romans 12:1-2, 14:13; I John 2:15-17; II John 9-11; II Corinthians 6:14-7:1
