After about another hour of deliberating whether they would let us through or not, they finally let us go. We made it to the rental car desk one minute before they closed (because of quarantine restrictions we were not allowed to take public transportation). Then we drove jetlagged and exhausted to our home five hours away and arrived safely at 4AM.

I struggled whether or not to tell you that because I don't want to come across as complaining. Through all that craziness, God was working! As we waited in quarantine, the workers gave food to the kids, despite the vomiting and a discrepancy with our paper work, we were allowed to enter Japan, and though we were jet-lagged and exhausted God kept us safe for the drive home. Thank you for praying for our trip home as it was apparent to us God did miraculous things to bring us back.
